NEW BUSINESS

ORV ROUTES

A motion was made by Hoefflerle, second by Moskwa, (CARRIED) to recommend to the council, a letter of support be written to MDOT to agree with the ORV use on the pedestrian path/snowmobile trail to cross the M-64 bridge until alternative route becomes available.

A motion was made by Hoefflerle, second by Kattelus, (CARRIED) to recommend Plan 2 routing into town to the council and then onto MDOT.

A motion was made by Moskwa, second by Kattelus, (CARRIED) to designate primary trail route out of town to use Michigan Ave. – to N. 7th Street – to Paul Bunyan Ave. This suggested route will be reviewed with the council and MiTrail.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- **Commission member M. Hoefflerle would like to put littering on the beached on the next agenda.**
- **Commission member D. Kattelus brought up the fireworks issues. Manager discussed that it is going to the Senate for review and has the possibilities of limiting the hours during Holidays. It was suggested we invite the Sheriff to the next meeting to discuss.**
