- The Building Committee met with OHM Engineers about the specification of the Lakeshore lighting project.

A motion was made by Wagner, second by Miller, (CARRIED) to keep the Lakeshore lighting lambs congruent with the downtown lighting visually.

- Make a Mini Plan for the RICC Park in the future.
