AUTHORIZATION OF THE 2021-22 TAX LEVY

At an electronic meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Ontonagon, held on the 22nd day of March, 2021, in the offices at 315 Quartz Street, Ontonagon, Michigan, the following resolution was offered by Trustee Hopper and supported by Trustee Rebholz:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 14 (1) of Act 621 of the Public Act of 1978, the Interim Village Manager, as the Chief Administrative Officer, has prepared and presented the Village Council with a balanced budget; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2021, the Ontonagon Village Council approved a general appropriations act for Fiscal Year 2021-22 authorizing the expenditures of the Village funds; and

WHEREAS, the millage rate is necessary to raise revenues for Village operating and debt retirement purposes:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Village Treasurer is hereby authorized to levy and collect the following millage rates for the 2021-22 Fiscal Year:

GENERAL FUND OPERATION & DEBT: 15.00 Mills
TOTAL: 15.00 Mills


