**A RESOLUTION TO EXEMPT THE VILLAGE OF ONTONAGON FROM THE
REQUIRMENTS OF P.A. 152 OF 2011 FOR THE YEAR OF 2021**

At a regular meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Ontonagon, held on the 13th day of December, 2021, in the offices at 315 Quartz Street, Ontonagon, Michigan, the following resolution was offered by Trustee Rebholz and supported by Trustee Chastan:

WHEREAS, Act 152 of Public Acts of 2011, as amended, known as the Publicly Funded Health Insurance Contribution Act, requires that the Village of Ontonagon consider a “hard cap” or cost sharing for health insurance premiums for any new employee contracts, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Act, the Village Council by 2/3rds vote exempt the Village from these requirements.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Ontonagon be exempt from the requirements of P.A. 152 for the medical benefit plan coverage year January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.
